High-Impact Activities

- Leverage existing business attraction initiatives such as a trade mission
- Create a PA Energy Infrastructure Commission to coordinate federal and private investments around energy infrastructure (examples in VA, KY, other states)
 Also focus on transportation of carbon
- Develop three scenarios for PA's clean energy/economy future; identify pros and cons, gaps, and what actions need to be taken

Legislator Engagement & Education

- Legislation and regulatory advancement; public education and meetings
- Tackle permitting through legislation
 - Focus on legislator engagement and education, education of PA youth (which will influence views of their parents and then views/actions of legislators)
 - Invest in technology to reduce costs

Communications & Awareness

- Communication to increase awareness of CCUS/H2, what actions the public can take to help; meet people where they are and deliver information on actions
 - Include a tool to measure change in public awareness and agreement with statements
 - Potential activities: hydrogen bus, outreach coordinator
- Synthesize existing studies and resources
 - E.g. toolkit, create a highlights document
 - Desired outcome would be to mobilize stakeholders
- Educate and engage PA Governor on importance of CCUS/H2, enable him to take action to support
 - Create a synthesized and concise message to share with the Governor
- Multi-state engagement and coordination tri-state and beyond
 - Engage governors in neighboring states
 - Regional (cross-state) summit
 - Coordination among agencies in multiple states
