budget. If there is ample opportunity to explore this topic beyond what is feasible in this engagement, we may consider this an area

ripe for future, follow-on work.

Question: What "style" of report are you interested in? Whereas the 2018

report was written as a "traditional" written report the 2021 report was written as more of a high-level "PPT". Did the authors of the

published) or was what is on your website the full deliverable?
